Successful use of the thermal imaging camera (TIC) in structure fire search and rescue operations has been documented. TICs have many applications. Course will cover these and many other applications for this technology. Course objectives include proper use of the TIC and operating techniques, understanding the TIC technology and limitations, applying the TIC to fireground operations, interpreting the thermal image and flashover recognition, fireground safety, and incorporating the TIC into your department training.

Strategy selection considerations, strategy modification cues, and offensive-to-defensive / defensive to offensive strategic transition will be a focus for discussion.
